

CURRICULUM & RESOURCES

Christ to the World Ministries focuses on bringing persons to a saving knowledge of and faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. This guide provides an overview of our Ministry and our Mission.

Resources

We produce a combination of printed and audio resources centered upon the Word of God. The resources are in the areas of pre-evangelism, evangelism, and discipleship. All of the resources use primarily the "storying" method of conveying the truths of Scripture.

We presently produce five different types of resources. These resources allow broadcasters flexibility in their planning and programming.

Christian Radio Dramas

These dramas, 20 minutes in length, are in the areas of preevangelism and evangelism. Based on Scripture, they are designed to awaken an interest in spiritual matters in the listener and stir within him a hunger for God. They are fast-paced and involve a great deal of action and dialogue. Each one ends with an invitation to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Deliverance Radio Programs

These programs, 25 minutes in length, are in the areas of evangelism and discipleship. Each program is a combination of the Christian radio drama and biblical teaching. The program begins with Scripture and an overview of the central truth to be learned. Then the drama follows. Teaching at the conclusion of the drama summarizes and reinforces the central truth depicted. The program ends with an invitation to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Bible Study Leaflets

These four-page study leaflets are designed to be studied by the persons who are reached by the radio broadcasts of the dramas and other radio programs produced by Christ to the World. They are in the areas of evangelism and discipleship. Cover artwork conveys a truth from the study and arouses interest. Each leaflet ends with an invitation to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Brief follow-up is given for those who trust Christ. The leaflets can be mailed to recipients, and they can also be posted on the Internet.

Hear the Word Radio Episodes

These programs, 18 minutes in length, are in the areas of evangelism and discipleship. Based on the Bible study leaflets, each program involves a teacher and two colleagues who discuss the biblical passage and make application of the scriptural truths. Each program ends with an invitation to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.

Bible Study Guides

These study guides, 10-12 pages in length, are a longer version of the Bible study leaflets and are also in the areas of evangelism and discipleship. They are interactive in design to involve the learner, and they use creative artwork throughout. A leader guide is included whereby a person can lead a group study. Each guide ends with an invitation to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Brief follow-up is given for those who trust Christ. The guides can be mailed to recipients, and they can also be posted on the Internet.

The Power of Storytelling:

The basic drama program approach is that of the Bible story. Everyone loves stories. Jesus did not follow the sermonic model most preachers, and many teachers, use today. Rather, He told stories. And the people listened. They loved them. And they remembered the stories He told. Oral cultures in many parts of the world rely almost exclusively on stories in communicating and teaching. Missionaries have rediscovered the effectiveness of using Bible stories. Conveying the truths of Scripture in story form makes a lasting impression upon the reader/hearer. Bible stories are easy to remember. And they are a great aid when the person wants to share the truths he/she has learned with someone else.

SPECIAL SERIES

KNOWING THE ONE TRUE GOD

Description

This is a series of 8 dramas/study guides based on key biblical truths about God. The series is not just a presentation of the doctrine of God; rather, it is designed to lead the listener/reader to experientially know the one true God.

Purpose

The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

HOW TO RECEIVE FORGIVENESS AND ETERNAL LIFE

Description: This series of four dramas presents God's plan of salvation. The love and grace of God, the fact of sin, the death of Christ on the cross for sinners, and faith and repentance are clearly presented.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to commit his or her life to Jesus Christ and to follow in baptism and a life of discipleship.

GREAT NIGHTS OF THE BIBLE

Description: This is a series of 17 dramas/study guides on many of the great nights of the Bible. The epochal events that took place on these nights give insight into the nature of God and His providential involvement in the affairs of humanity. Some men turned to God in the nighttime and found new life, while other men turned away and faced an eternal night.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The learner gains a broad overview of biblical history through the unforgettable stories of these nighttime events.

GREAT DAYS OF THE BIBLE

Description: This series of 10 studies highlights some of the very significant days in the Bible, days when God worked in unusual and unprecedented ways.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to commit his or her life to Jesus Christ and to follow in baptism and a life of discipleship.

GREAT MOUNTAINS OF THE BIBLE

Description: This is a series of 11 programs on some of the great mountains of the Bible and the epochal events that took place on them. These mountains are not considered great in themselves; they are great because of the events that transpired on them. These events give insight into the nature of God and His providential involvement in the affairs of humanity.

Purpose: The purpose of this series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The learner gains a broad overview of biblical history through the unforgettable stories of these mountain scenes.

GREAT OUESTIONS OF THE BIBLE

Description: This is a series of 12 dramas/study guides based on some of the great questions of the Bible. The questions rivet attention and focus the person's thinking on eternal issues.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

GREAT TRIALS OF MEN AND WOMEN IN THE BIBLE

Description: Trials of various kinds come to every person. No one is exempt. Testing and trials have always been a part of the human experience. This series of 12 programs describes the trials experienced by some of the men and women in the Bible.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

WOMEN WHO LIVED WITHOUT GOD

Description: This series of 9 programs tells the stories of nine women who lived without God. The Bible gives positive examples of people that we should seek to turn away from. This series of nine programs lifts up negative role models to be avoided.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

BOYS AND GIRLS IN THE BIBLE

Description: Boys and girls play an important role in the Bible. God used many of them in significant ways. This series of 11 programs tells the stories of some of those boys and girls and draws lessons from their lives that can help us.

Purpose: The purpose of this series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

GREAT PIONEER MISSIONARIES FOR JESUS

Description: This is a series of 16 dramas/study guides based on the lives of selected great pioneer missionaries for Jesus. The series is built upon the basis of the Great Commission, followed by dramatic portrayals of 14 pioneer missionaries to various parts of the world.

The series ends with the affirmation, Here Am I. Send Me, showing that the great missionary mandate applies to us today, in every culture and country of the world.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is twofold: (1) To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him, and (2) To lead Christian listeners/readers to be active witnesses for Jesus, wherever they are. God may use this series to call some believers into cross-culture missions.

OLD TESTAMENT SERIES

THE PROMISE OF A SAVIOR

Description: This series of 7 dramas/study guides traces God's promise of a Savior in the Old Testament. The promise of a coming Messiah is an unbroken thread running throughout Old Testament scripture. As God slowly but surely prepared the world for the coming of the Savior (Gal. 4:4-5), He also gave many predictions about His coming. From the more than 60 direct predictions of the Messiah, this series lifts up seven.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

GREAT PERSONALITIES OF THE OLD TESTAMENT (3-PART SERIES)

Description: This is a three-part series telling the stories of many of the great personalities of the Old Testament. Faith in God and in His provision is the unifying theme that binds these stories together, as Hebrews 11 clearly illustrates. Some of the stories, like that of king Saul, show the lack of faith in God and the shipwreck that occurs when a person trusts his own way rather than God's way. The programs provide a grand overview of the Old Testament.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and His provision for us: Jesus Christ. Just as the men and women of the Old Testament exercised their faith in God, so should persons today place their faith in God and receive the salvation He has provided through Jesus Christ. A secondary purpose is to provide the listener/reader with an overall view of the Old Testament and God's dealings with His people.

GREAT WOMEN OF THE OLD TESTAMENT

Description: This is a series of 15 dramas/study guides that tells the exciting stories of many of the great women of the Old Testament. These women were not great because of worldly accomplishments; they were great because of their faith in a great God and their obedience to Him. Faith in God is the unifying theme that binds these stories together.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and His provision for us, Jesus Christ. Just as the great women of the Old Testament exercised their faith in God, so should persons today place their faith in God and receive the salvation He has provided through Jesus Christ. A secondary purpose is to provide the listener/reader with an overall view of the Old Testament and God's dealings with His people.

GREAT PRAYERS OF THE OLD TESTAMENT

Description: This series of 14 dramas/study guides examines some of the great prayers of the Old Testament.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

THE LIFE OF ABRAHAM

Description: This series of 12 programs follows the life of the patriarch Abraham from his departure from Ur in Chaldea to his death in the land of Canaan at the age of 175. Throughout his life Abraham faced many trials, and through them all he was a man of steadfast faith. God promised Abraham that all peoples on earth would be blessed through him, a promise that found its fulfillment in the coming of the Messiah.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE STORY OF JOSEPH

Description: This series of 11 dramas/study guides traces the story of Joseph from a youth favored by his father to his reign over Egypt as prime minister and the reunion with his family to a coffin in Egypt.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE OF MOSES

Description: From among the bulrushes of the Nile to the lonely peak of Mt. Nebo lived one of the greatest figures in all Old Testament history. This series of 17 dramas/study guides traces the life of Moses, the great liberator and lawgiver.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to commit his or her life to Jesus Christ and to follow in baptism and a life of discipleship.

THE JUDGES OF ISRAEL

Description: This series of 9 programs traces the long period in Israel's history when God's people repeatedly turned away from God and went into sin and idolatry, and the subsequent judgment that came upon them. God's faithfulness and mercy are contrasted with the unfaithfulness of the people. The judges God raised up to deliver the people from foreign oppression show how God worked through ordinary men and women whom He chose.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE STORY OF RUTH

Description: This series of 4 dramas/study guides follows one of the most beautiful love stories of the Bible. It tells of the sojourn of Naomi's family in Moab and the sad events that took place there; the decision of Ruth to return with her mother-in-law; Ruth gleaning in the fields of Boaz; and the marriage of Ruth to Boaz.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE OF DAVID

Description: This series of 11 dramas/study guides portrays the life of David from his days as a shepherd boy in the fields of Bethlehem to his reign as king over Israel to his old age and death.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE PROPHETS OF GOD

Description: This is a series of 12 dramas/study guides based on the lives of some of the great prophets of God. In all of the prophets and their writings, the themes of God's love, sin, judgment, repentance, and God's forgiveness run throughout. These same themes are found in the gospel message today and are applicable in every culture in the world.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF ELLJAH

Description: This series of 9 studies examines the life and ministry of the prophet Elijah. As we study the bold and courageous adventures of this fiery man, we must remind ourselves that Elijah was a man "just like us" (James 5:17), and that we, too, can live for God in an evil day.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead persons to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and commit to a life of Christian discipleship.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF ELISHA

Description: This series of 8 programs examines the life and ministry of the prophet Elisha, the successor of Elijah. Elisha was a mighty prophet who lived totally for God. The studies show us what God can do with a person completely yielded to Him.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead persons to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

NEW TESTAMENT SERIES

WHO IS JESUS?

Description: This is a series of 8 dramas/study guides based on Jesus' revelation of Himself in the Gospel of John. The series is built primarily around the great "I Am" statements of Jesus.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The series provides the listener/reader with unique insights into the Person of Jesus through metaphors of everyday objects and concepts people are familiar with.

AFFIRMATIONS ABOUT JESUS CHRIST

Description: This is a series of 8 dramas/study guides on affirmations about Jesus Christ, who He is and what He did.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The learner will gain an understanding of the person and work of Christ.

PERSONS WHO MET JESUS

Description: This is a series of 13 studies of persons who met Jesus. Emphasis is on how their lives were changed by meeting the Savior.

THE LIFE OF CHRIST

Description: This series of 25 studies provides an overview of the life and ministry of Christ, with special emphasis on His supernatural birth, His mighty works, His teachings, and His death on the cross for our sins, and His resurrection from the dead.

Introductory Study: The Promise of a Savior.

ENCOUNTERS WITH JESUS

Description: This series of dramas and Bible study leaflets will deal with encounters with Jesus by various persons from throughout His ministry. Half of these studies deal with healing encounters; the other studies deal with various other types of encounters. All are teaching encounters. In these studies we learn of the mighty power of Jesus to save and transform a person's life. The word encounter is a key word in the series. Just as the individuals who encountered Jesus during His earthly ministry were changed, so persons today who encounter Christ are changed. The encounters follow Jesus' ministry chronologically as set forth in Robertson's *A Harmony of the Gospels*. A chronological approach allows the listener/reader to follow the life of Jesus through the encounters.

Purpose: The purpose of this series of studies is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to commit his or her life to Jesus Christ and to follow in baptism and a life of discipleship.

QUESTIONS JESUS ASKED

Description: This is a series of 10 dramas/study guides based on questions Jesus asked during His ministry. Jesus often used questions to cause His listeners to think about important things in life. The sequence of the following questions follows the chronology of Robertson's *A Harmony of the Gospels*.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. There is a strong emphasis in the questions on obedience and following Jesus.

GREAT PRAYERS OF THE NEW TESTAMENT

Description: This series of 14 dramas/study guides is based on some of the great prayers of the New Testament. The prayers of Jesus to His Father were marked by trust and intimacy. The prayers of persons in the Gospels to Jesus were marked by urgency, sincerity, faith and brevity.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The listener/reader will understand how to talk to God.

MEN WHO MISSED THE WAY

Description: The early church used the term "Way" to describe their movement. With intent to kill, Saul went to Damascus in search of "any there who belonged to the Way" (Acts 9:2), in order to take them prisoners to Jerusalem. Other references to the Way are found in Acts 19:9, 23: 22:4; 24:14, 22.

The early Christians proclaimed Jesus Christ as the way of salvation (Acts 16:17) and the way to God (1 Tim. 2:5). Jesus said, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me" (John 14:6). Peter declared to the leaders of Israel: "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12). But many persons in the days of the early church missed the Way. They refused to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. Many were like Felix, "who was well acquainted with the Way (Acts 24:22), yet refused to believe.

This series of 12 dramas/study guides tells the story of 12 men who missed the Way. For various reasons, they turned away from the truth, and, as a result, faced eternal night.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE CHRISTMAS STORY

Description: This series of 8 programs tells the beautiful story of the birth of our Savior. Beginning with the Old Testament prophecies of the coming of the Messiah, the series tells of Mary and Joseph and the scenes surrounding the birth of Jesus.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE SUFFERING SAVIOR

Description: This series of 9 programs focuses on the final hours of Jesus' earthly ministry. The prophet Isaiah foretold the sufferings of the Savior: "his appearance was so disfigured beyond that of any man and his form marred beyond human likeness" (Isa. 52:14). Yet the greatest suffering of all was not physical; it was the suffering Jesus endured when He took the load of human sin upon Himself (2 Cor. 5:21) and the Father turned away from Him (Mt. 27:46). This series clearly shows that Christ died for us (Rom. 5:8).

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE RISEN SAVIOR

Description: This series of 7 programs tells the story of the resurrection of Jesus and His appearances to His disciples over a period of 40 days.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE GLORIFIED SAVIOR

Description: This series of 6 programs deals with scenes after Jesus was resurrected and ascended back into heaven.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF JOHN THE BAPTIST

Description: This series of four dramas/study guides highlights the life and ministry of John the Baptist.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE GOSPEL OF MARK (5-PART SERIES)

Description: Mark's Gospel was the first of the Gospels to be written. It is the Gospel of action, giving an account of the mighty acts of Jesus. One scholar writes about Mark: "*He tells the Good News about Jesus Christ so simply that a child can understand it.*" This five-part series consists of a total of 43 programs.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him. The listener/reader will gain an overall understanding of the life and ministry of Jesus.

SELECTED PARABLES IN THE GOSPEL OF LUKE

Description: Jesus told many parables to illustrate spiritual truths. Some of the parables He told are found only in Luke's Gospel. This series of 7 programs examines some of these parables and draws lessons from them for our lives today.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE TWELVE DISCIPLES OF JESUS

Description: Jesus called a very ordinary group of men to be His followers. These 12 men left everything to follow Jesus. For more than three years they followed their Master throughout Galilee and Judea, listening to His words, watching His actions. They were His constant companions. When Jesus ascended back into heaven, He left these men responsible for spreading His gospel throughout the world. These disciples obeyed Jesus' mandate and made an indelible impact on the world. This series of 12 programs examines the lives of these disciples and draws lessons we can learn from them.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF SIMON PETER

Description: This series of 19 programs depicts the life and ministry of Simon Peter, from his days as a fisherman on the Sea of Galilee to the two letters he wrote to the scattered Christians, not long before his death.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF APOSTLE JOHN

Description: This series of 8 programs depicts the life and ministry of the apostle John, from his days as a fisherman on the Sea of Galilee to his last days on the rocky island of Patmos.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust God and place his/her faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE EARLY CHRISTIAN CHURCH

Description: This is the thrilling account of the early Christian church as portrayed in the first 12 chapters of Acts.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF THE APOSTLE PAUL (3-PART SERIES)

Description: This is a three-part series based on Acts 13-28, along with parts of Acts 7, 8, 9, 11, 12, and selected portions of his letters to the churches. It follows the life and ministry of the apostle Paul from his early background and persecution of the church to his dramatic conversion and then his ministry across the Greco-Roman world, ending with him facing martyrdom in Rome.

Paul was born most likely in the first decade of the first century and was executed probably in A.D. 67. His conversion likely took place in A.D. 35. The events in Acts 13-28 took place during the years A.D. 47-63.

Purpose: The series is evangelistic in nature, showing the universality of the Gospel; that any person can receive forgiveness of sin and eternal life by trusting Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord. The series demonstrates the mighty power of God to break down the strongholds of Satan and bring men and women to the light of His truth. It shows how God guided the spread of Christianity from Jerusalem to the ends of the earth.

PERSONS IN THE BOOK OF ACTS WHO MET JESUS

Description: This series of 10 dramas/study guides is built around 10 persons who met Jesus, as recounted in the book of Acts.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

COWORKERS WITH THE APOSTLE PAUL

Description: This series of 10 programs tells the stories of some of Paul's colleagues as he ministered across the Roman Empire. Whereas Paul is the most well known of the early missionaries, he was not alone. Many others helped him in the work. This series examines some of those lives and the lessons we can learn from them.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

LITTLE KNOWN PERSONS IN THE NEW TESTAMENT

Description: There are many persons mentioned in the New Testament about whom we know very little. But no person is insignificant; each one is important. This series of 11 programs tells the stories of some of those persons and gleans lessons from their lives that will benefit us.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and follow Him.

THE LIFE AND MINISTRY OF JOHN MARK

Description: This series of 7 dramas/study guides follows the life and ministry of the man who wrote the first Gospel.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to trust Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and follow Him.

THE LETTERS OF THE APOSTLE PAUL

Description: This series of 13 dramas/study guides presents the letters of the apostle Paul. Each drama is built around one or more incidents related to the particular letter Paul wrote; the study guide gives a synopsis and overview of the letter, reflecting its central message.

Purpose: The purpose of the series is evangelistic: To lead the listener/reader to commit his or her life to Jesus Christ and to follow in baptism and a life of discipleship.
